**Kindergarten Immunization Requirements 2015-2016**

Michigan law requires that the parent/guardian of every kindergarten student must provide an immunization record that documents that the child has received **all** of the required immunizations or at least one dose of each required immunization and is not yet due for the next dose. If a nonmedical waiver is desired, the parent/guardian must make an appointment at Washtenaw County Public Health to receive science-based vaccine education and a certified waiver.

**The immunization record is due at registration or no later than the first day of school.**

Refer to the chart below to determine if your child is up-to-date with their vaccines. Schedule an appointment immediately if your child is in need of vaccines so there will be no delay in your child's admission to school.

**Required Immunizations for Entry requirements for all Michigan Public and Non-Public School**  
**Kindergarteners Aged 4-6 years**

Vaccine **	Doses
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis	4 doses of DTP or DTaP, one dose must be on or after 4 years of age
Polio	4 doses, if dose 3 administered on or after 4 years of age, only three doses are required
Measles, Mumps, Rubella*	2 doses on or after 12 months of age
Hepatitis B*	3 doses
Varicella*(chickenpox)	2 doses on or after 12 months of age or current lab immunity or reliable history of disease

- \* Current laboratory evidence of immunity is acceptable instead of immunization with antigen
- \*\*All doses of vaccine must be given with appropriate spacing between doses and at appropriate ages to be considered valid.
- Hepatitis A and a yearly Influenza vaccine are additional vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices and the American Academy of Pediatrics.
